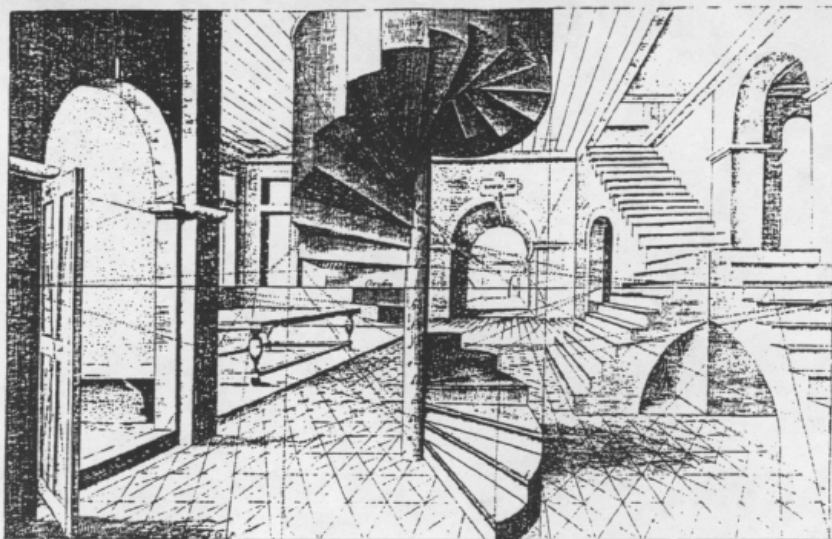

## CHICHILNISKY AWARDED SALIMBENI PROFESSORSHIP IN SIENA

**Prof. Graciela Chichilnisky**, Professor of Economics at Columbia University, has just been awarded the 1994 Salimbeni Professorship at the University of Siena.

The Salimbeni Professorship is a yearly position held by a prominent economist in the area of international trade and finance. It is supported by the Monte de Paschi di Siena Bank, dating back to 1476. This honor was held last year by Prof. Robert Solow of MIT, a Nobel Laureate in Economics.

Last December, Prof. Chichilnisky was in Siena to give a public lecture in connection with the Salimbeni Chair, on European Union Strategies in the World Economics. In the Spring of 1995, Prof. Chichilnisky will teach several lectures, a number of them public, a number of them to the Department of Economics at the University of Siena, and some to the senior executives (including the President) of the Monte de Paschi di Siena Bank.
